The Feast of the Presentation



Today we celebrate the Feast of the Presentation of Christ in the Jerusalem Temple – the feast is actually on February 2nd, forty days (inclusive) after Christmas Day.

Today's gospel tells the encounter of the young child Jesus and his parents with Simeon and Anna. Simeon immediately recognises Jesus as the Messiah who they have waited for a long time. Because of this he says he is now ready to die, saying the now familiar words of the Nunc Dimittis, a favourite canticle for Evening Prayer:

*Now, Lord, you let your servant go in peace:
your word has been fulfilled.
My own eyes have seen the salvation
which you have prepared in the sight of every people;
A light to reveal you to the nations
and the glory of your people Israel.*

Luke 2:29-32

Anna began to praise God and spoke of the long awaited child and the work of redemption of all people to which he is called.

After they had finished everything required by the law of the Lord, they go back home to Nazareth.
